Policy on Guns in CRHA Properties

1. CRHA will take a similar policy line as that adopted by Devon and Cornwall Constabulary and other Registered Providers with regard to the keeping of guns on CRHA's residential premises, as follows:
2. Permission will be given to any customer to keep a gun within their property subject to the following conditions:-
 - A formal request to keep a gun is made in writing (email) to CRHA.
 - A copy of the Gun Licence is supplied with the written request.
 - The gun and any ammunition are stored in a lockable purpose built gun cabinet.
 - Devon and Cornwall Police are formally notified that a gun is stored at the property.
 - The gun and gun cabinet will be inspected periodically by CRHA's Tenancy Management Officer and a Police Officer to ensure that the gun licence is still enforced, and all other conditions set out in the policy are being met.
 - A record and photograph of the gun licence will be recorded on our system and monitored to ensure validity.
3. Customers would be advised:
 - Any permission to keep a gun at the property could be revoked if the customer/s breaches their tenancy agreement.
 - Permission will be immediately withdrawn if a gun licence is revoked or not renewed by Devon and Cornwall Police.
4. Permission will not normally be given for more than one gun to be stored at the property.
5. CRHA will maintain a register of customers who have been given permission to keep a gun at the property.
6. This policy will be reviewed triennially or more frequently if required.
